INCORPORATION OF SUBSIDIARIES

The Board of Directors of Q & M Dental Group (Singapore) Limited (the “Company” and together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”) wishes to announce that Q & M Dental Group (China) Pte Ltd (“QMDGC”) has incorporated two new subsidiaries on 17 May 2010. The Company owns an equity interest of 99% in QMDGC.

QMDGC has set up the following wholly-owned subsidiaries in Singapore:

- 1) Q & M Dental (Beijing) Pte. Ltd. which has an initial issued and paid up capital of S\$2 comprising 10 shares; and
- 2) Q & M Dental (Shanghai) Pte. Ltd. which has an initial issued and paid up capital of S\$2 comprising 2 shares.

The principal activities of these new subsidiaries are investment holding and provision of services related to the dental healthcare business. None of the Company’s directors or controlling shareholder has any interest, direct or indirect, in the above transaction (other than their shareholdings in the Company).
