## ENTRY INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY EM2AI PTE. LTD. IN RELATION TO DENTAL AI SOLUTIONS

- The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Q & M Dental Group (Singapore) Limited (the "Company", and collectively with its subsidiaries, the "Group") refers to its announcement dated 13 January 2025 ("Previous Announcement"), regarding the receipt of medical device licenses in Thailand, Philippines, Vietnam and Indonesia by EM2AI Pte. Ltd. ("EM2AI"), a 49% associated company of the Group, through its representative(s).
- Further to the Previous Announcement, the Board is pleased to announce that EM2AI has entered into a memorandum of understanding ("MOU") with an established provider of dental solutions in the region, serving a network of approximately 1,000 dental clinics (the "Customer" and collectively with EM2AI, the "Parties"). This collaboration is part of the Board's plan for EM2AI to expand its business network in the region and represents a strategic step toward expanding EM2AI's footprint in key regional markets.
- Pursuant to the MOU, the Parties have agreed to collaborate, with EM2AI granting the Customer a license to integrate its dental artificial intelligence ("AI") solutions into the Customer's platform. This partnership will enable the seamless deployment of EM2AI's dental AI solutions across the Customer's network of dental clinics in Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, and Vietnam (the "Proposed Co-operation"). Securing its first key overseas client with an established regional presence represents a key milestone for EM2AI.
- The Parties will negotiate and agree upon the terms of separate written binding agreements in relation to the Proposed Co-operation ("**Definitive Agreement(s)**"). The MOU will remain in effect for a period of six (6) months or until the Definitive Agreement(s) is signed, whichever occurs earlier. The MOU may be extended for further periods as mutually agreed by the Parties in writing. Either Party may terminate the MOU by providing six (6) months' prior written notice.
- 5 Should the Proposed Co-operation materialise, EM2AI will provide its dental AI solutions to over 1,100 clinics across Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam. As EM2AI grows and expands its network of users in the region, the Board expects this will contribute to the creation of shareholder value.
- The Company will make further announcement(s) as and when there are any material developments in the business of EM2AI.
